 How did Jane Jacobs, Rachel Carson, and Barbara Ward influence our approach of sustainability? Jane Jacobs 'book The Death and Life of Great American Cities really changes the way people see cities. Silent Spring by a scientist, Rachel Carson examined at the disappearance of birds in the United States.
